Appendix A: Notes

The Birmingham 2022 Commonwealth Games will take place between 28th July 2022 and 08th August 2022 with athletes and representatives in attendance from around the world. Due to the scale and complexity of such an event over multiple venues, West Midlands Police has sponsored a restriction of airspace across the region as part of the security operation. Whilst the intention is not to impact air traffic movements significantly, we hope that the aviation industry/ communities understand the necessity for increased security measures, including the airspace.

For the period of 0600hrs UTC 28th July 2022 to 0600hrs UTC 9th August 2022 inclusive, any flight operations within the RA(T) not exempt by the Aeronautical Information Circular 064/2022, will require prior permission from West Midlands Police.

Any unauthorised flight into or within the restricted airspace is forbidden. This applies to **ALL** aircraft (inc drones; remote controlled aircraft; paramotors; and un-powered platforms such as paragliders and balloons). A permissive process will be in place for those wishing to fly within the boundaries of the RA(T) during its hours of operation. This again applies to all aircraft.

Please note that permission to enter/ operate within the RA(T) will be assessed on a case by case basis, but transits through this airspace will not be permitted.

Applications must be submitted in writing during business hours (0900-1700) at least 2 days prior to the intended date of operation. Completed request forms are to be sent to cw_aircell@westmidlands.police.uk . Authorised flights will be granted a unique reference number by West Midlands Police which should be inputted in field 18 of your flight plan. The associated reference number will be shared with relevant airfields.

Please be aware that approval is not confirmed until this reference number has been sent back to you from West Midlands Police.
